Info 12/23: Information on digitalisation of CO₂ enforcement services – No 4

The first CO₂ enforcement applications were launched on the DETEC eGovernment portal on 16 October 2023. On the portal it is possible to:

- register as a large importer / emissions pool
- edit large importer or emissions pool details
- manage assignment powers

Numerous large importers have already registered and completed their registration as importers or emissions pools. In order for CO₂ enforcement to be processed via the DETEC eGovernment portal, all large importers must be registered on the portal and have completed registration as importers or emissions pools.

All large importers must register as soon as possible. Register by 31 December 2023 at the latest in order to ensure access to the services.

Granting assignment powers

Authorisation to make assignments can be issued or deleted using the 'Manage assignment powers' service. **Assignment powers must be managed via this service.** This is to ensure that assignments are processed correctly.

NB: *If a power of attorney has been set up, the agent can enter the grantor as an involved party in a notification of assignment without the grantor having to subsequently confirm that a power of attorney has been set up. If no power of attorney has been set up for assignments, each party involved (with the exception of the notifying party) must confirm the assignment after submitting the assignment form in the eGovernment portal.*

Correct data and clear processes and responsibilities

Large importers should ensure that they create an eIAM login and enter the necessary details correctly. Incorrectly entered details (e.g. incorrect email address) will mean that processes cannot be carried out correctly. Care must be taken to ensure that any changes and responsibilities within the organisation are clearly regulated and communicated to the employees involved.

UID already assigned on DETEC eGovernment portal

Services from a number of DETEC offices are available on the DETEC eGovernment portal. An organisation or its UID may therefore already be registered on the portal for another service. The organisation must nonetheless be registered again (activate checkbox). The additional information on CO₂ enforcement must be indicated in lines 2 and 3 to ensure that the organisation is correctly recognised.





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Assignments as of January 1, 2024

Based on Art. 22a of the CO₂ Ordinance, assignments must now be reported to the SFOE and no longer to FEDRO from January 1, 2024. The notification to the SFOE is made exclusively by e-mail to co2-auto@bfe.admin.ch. The revised SFOE application form must be used. The UID must now also be stated on the form. If several vehicles are ceded, the SFOE Excel template must be used. The number of vehicles must also be entered on the form. Copies of documents can be sent to the SFOE as attachments by e-mail. It is no longer necessary to submit these documents by post.

The SFOE is working on a solution to enable digital assignments via the DETEC eGovernment portal. Industry stakeholders will be informed about the status of work and implementation in the first quarter of 2024.
