Introduction of vehicle assignment services via the DETEC eGovernment portal

On 25 March 2024, three additional digital services will be available on the DETEC eGovernment portal. These relate to the **assignment of passenger cars and light commercial vehicles**.

The new digital services will make the previous practice of notifying vehicle assignments to the SFOE by email obsolete. As of the above-mentioned date, this procedure will be discontinued and can no longer be used. **From 25 March 2024 on, vehicle assignments must be notified exclusively using the digital services on the DETEC eGovernment portal.** Please note that any assignments submitted by email after 25 March will **not be recorded and therefore will not be valid**.

The three new services can be found under 'CO₂ enforcement for large importers'. They are:

- **Notification of assignment:** This service can be used to notify assignments of passenger cars and light commercial vehicles (replaces individual assignment by email). A registered large importer can use this service to notify assignments to another large importer or to process the taking over of an assignment. In addition, assignments can be taken over from small importers, or an assignment can be notified as an intermediary between large importers. This service has no legal effect.
- **Notifications of assignment via Excel:** With this service, large importers can assign their passenger cars and light commercial vehicles by means of Excel lists (replaces batch assignment by email with an Excel table). The standard template must be used. It is available in the service on the DETEC eGovernment portal. The portal checks the vehicles on the Excel list and informs you whether the assignment has been completed. This service has no legal effect.
- **Analyse assignments:** With this service you can conduct an analysis of your organisation's assignments. These assignments can be exported as an Excel file.
