Info 11/24: Information on enforcing CO₂ regulations on heavy-duty vehicles (HDVs) - No. 2

From 1 January 2025, heavy-duty vehicles (HDVs) will also be subject to the CO₂ emissions regulations. On 11 October 2024, the SFOE published an initial [industry factsheet](#). In this second factsheet you will find information on using the DETEC eGovernment portal and calculating penalties.

Services on the DETEC eGovernment portal

The [DETEC eGovernment portal](#) is already in use for enforcing CO₂ regulations on cars and light commercial vehicles. In relation to HDVs, it is used to record importers and any assignments between importers. On 25 November, the following services will be launched to enforce the regulations on HDVs:

- Registering as a large-scale importer / emissions pool
- Editing details for large-scale importer or emissions pool
- Managing assignment powers

The three services mentioned above are a prerequisite for ensuring that the regulations can be enforced smoothly from 1 January 2025. All importers wishing to place new HDVs on the market for the first time must register on the [DETEC eGovernment portal](#) as an importer, regardless of the number of (planned) new registrations. Additional services will be launched at the beginning of January, in particular for the certification of vehicles without type approval. Further information on these will follow.

To help you get started on the [DETEC eGovernment portal](#), we have provided a guide in the Annex. This shows you the most important steps. However, you should note that the services relating to CO₂ regulations are currently unavailable in English. In order to make use of the services, you must use either the German, French or Italian version of the portal.

Calculating the penalty

The calculation is not guaranteed to be accurate, is not legally binding and is for information purposes only. It does not lead to an invoice being issued. Invoices for the penalties due on vehicles for 2025 will be issued in the first half of 2026.

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Guide to using the DETEC eGovernment portal

Services relating to CO₂ regulations are currently unavailable in English. In order to make use of the services, you must use either the German, French or Italian version of the portal. The webpages for creating your eIAM login are however available in English.

Step 1: Log in to the DETEC portal

NB: If you already have an eIAM login for the SharePoint server, you can skip Step 1.

The DETEC eGovernment portal is the central platform for all DETEC eGovernment services for use by the general public, businesses and other organisations. The digital services on this portal make it easy for you to conduct your official business wherever and whenever you like.

Once you have created your login, you will receive an email confirming your registration.

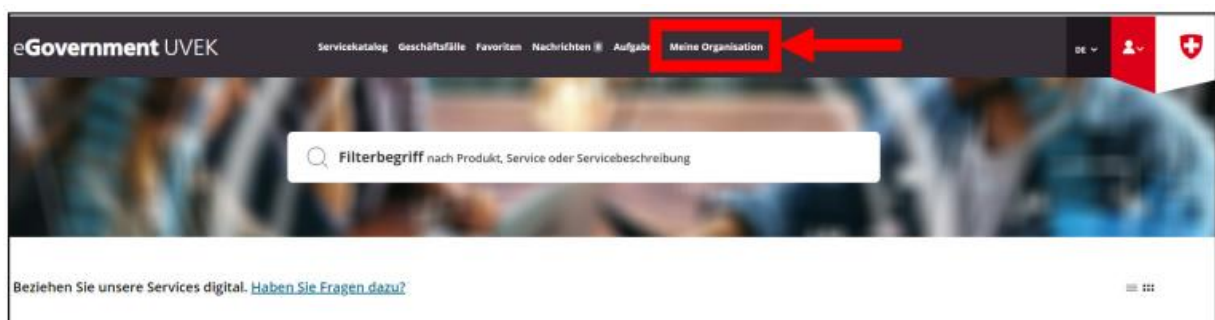
At present, it is possible to login to the DETEC eGovernment portal using the English version of the site. Certain pages containing menus and information are available in English. However, as the services themselves are not currently available in English, the following steps are explained using the German version of the site.

Step 2: Create and manage an organisation

Log in to the DETEC eGovernment portal with your eIAM login:

Under 'Meine Organisation' (My Organisation), you can select various platform services:



Under 'Organisation anlegen' (Create organisation), select 'Zum Service' (Go to service):

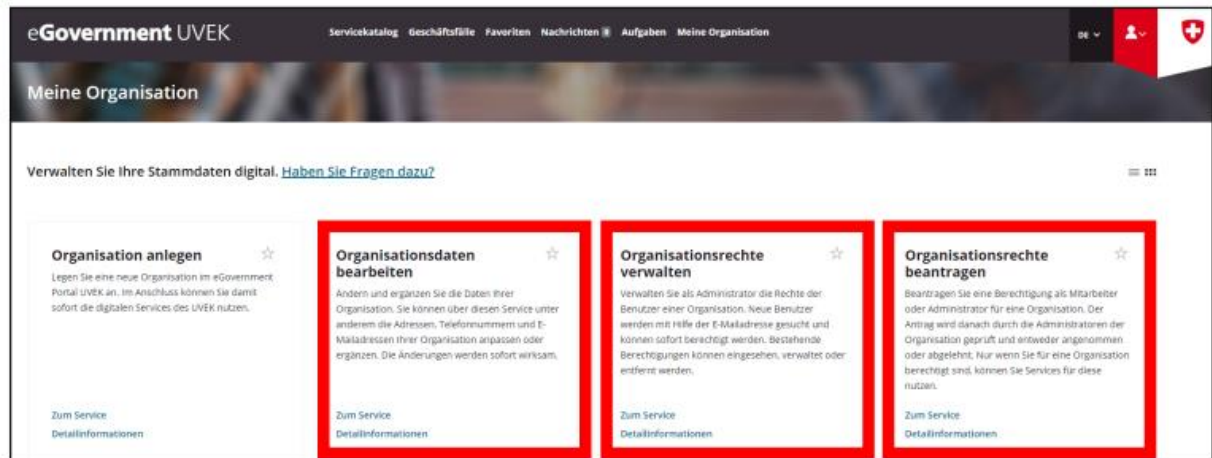


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You will now be guided through the individual steps in the service. At the end, you will receive a confirmation email with all the details of the organisation you have created.

With the other services, you can now manage your organisation by yourself. This includes the services 'Organisationsdaten bearbeiten' (Edit organisation data), 'Organisationsrechte verwalten' (Manage organisation rights) and 'Organisationsrechte beantragen' (Request organisation rights):

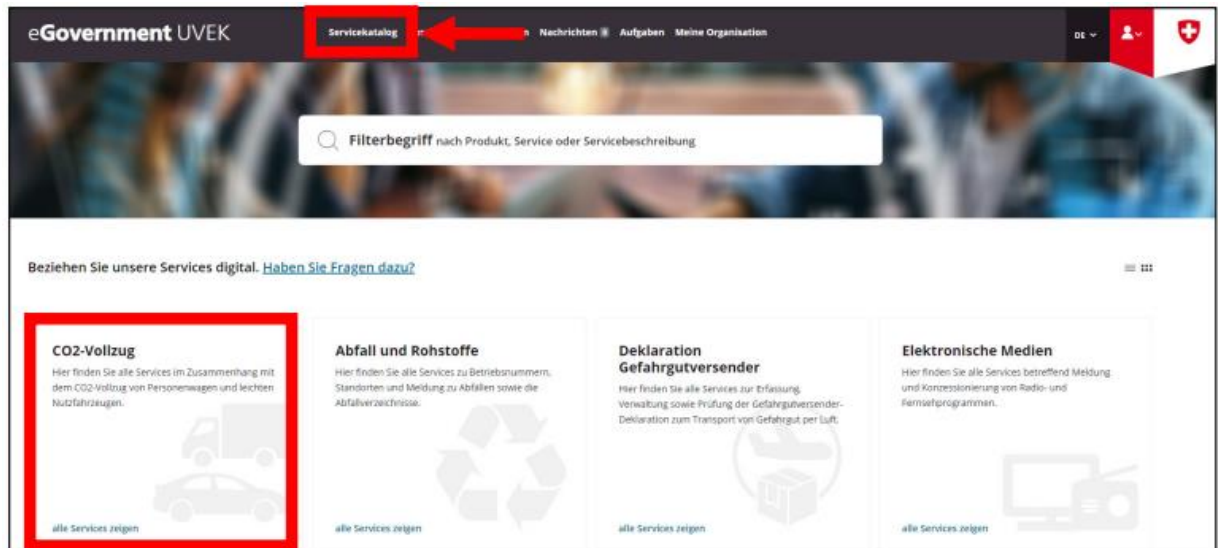


Step 3: Request to be treated as a large-scale importer

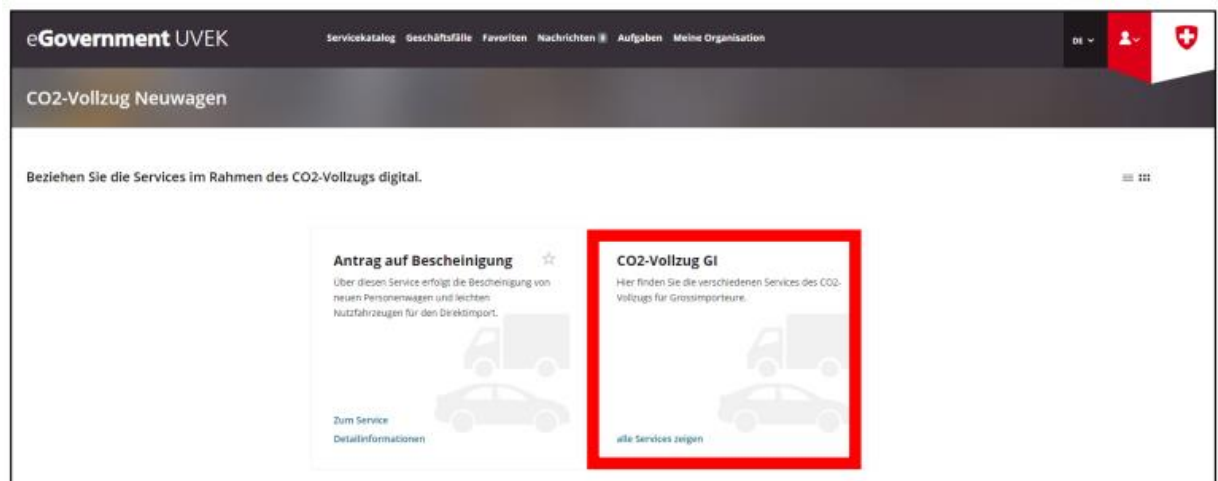
Switch back to the 'Servicekatalog'. Here you will find 'CO₂-Vollzug' (CO₂ emission regulations):



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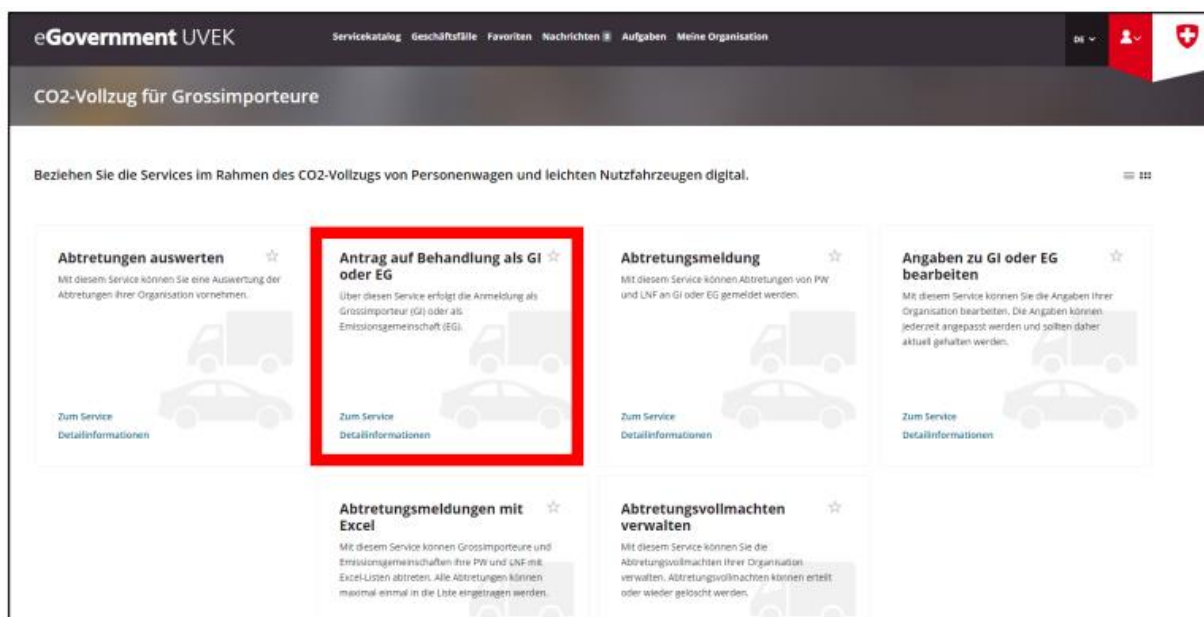
Click on 'alle Services anzeigen' (View all services). In the next window, under 'CO2-Vollzug GI' (CO2 Regulations for large-scale importers), select 'alle Services anzeigen' again.



Under 'Antrag auf Behandlung als GI oder EG' (Application for treatment as a large-scale importer or emissions pool), select 'Zum Service' (Go to service):



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You will now be guided step-by-step through the registration process as a large-scale importer.

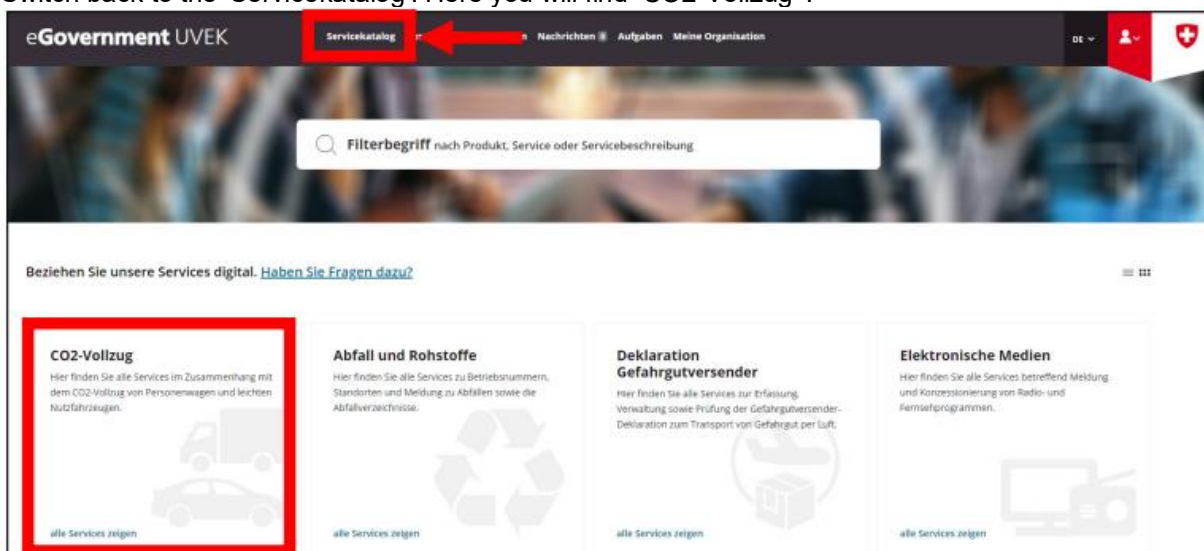
After completing the form, you will receive confirmation of your registration by email.

Step 4: Request to be treated as an emissions pool

Step 4 only needs to be carried out if you want to register an emissions pool.

All types of importers (large and small-scale and private importers) can join together to form an emissions pool. An emissions pool can be requested for a period of one to five years.

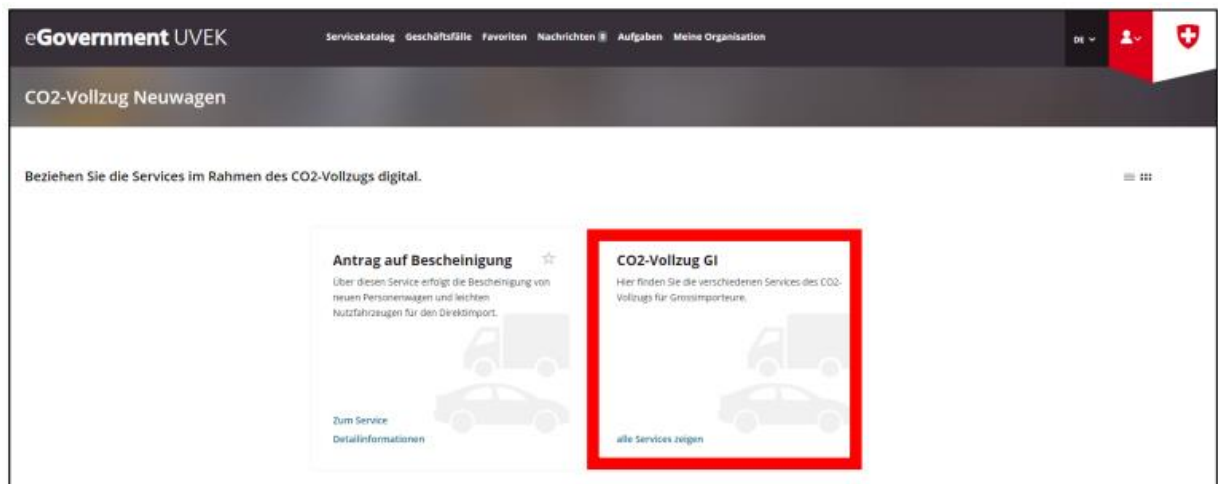
Switch back to the 'Servicekatalog'. Here you will find 'CO2-Vollzug':



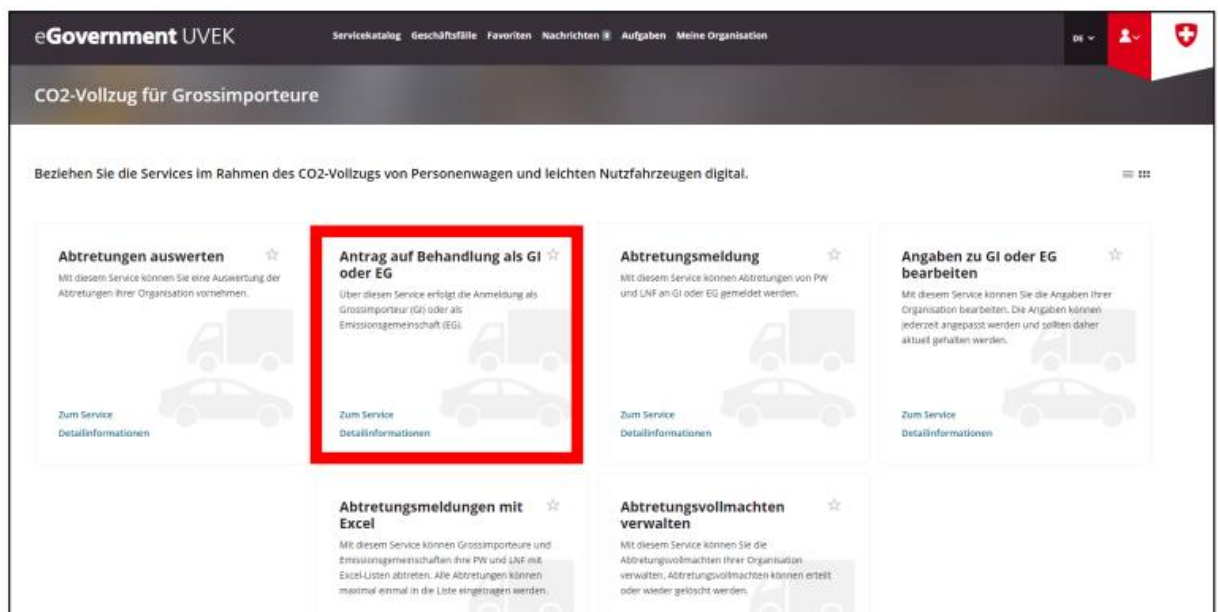
Click on 'alle Services anzeigen' (View all services). In the next window, under 'CO2-Vollzug GI' (CO2 Regulations for large-scale importers), select 'alle Services anzeigen' again.



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Under 'Antrag auf Behandlung als GI oder EG' (Application for treatment as a large-scale importer or emissions pool), select 'Zum Service' (Go to service):



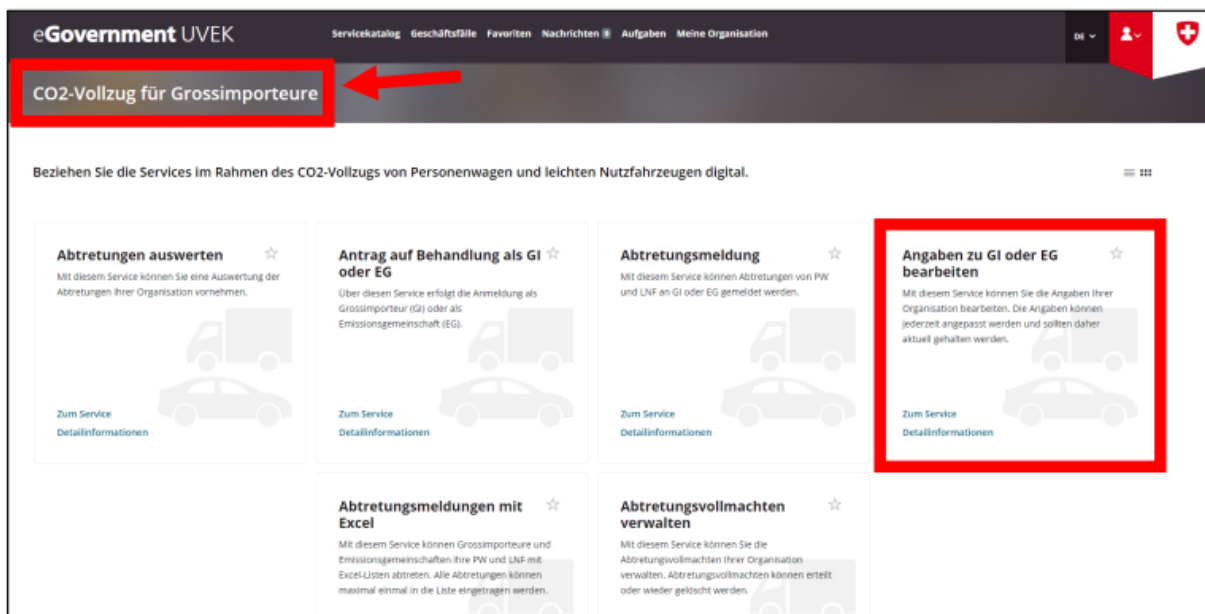
You will now be guided step-by-step through the registration process as an emissions pool. After completing the form, you will receive confirmation of your registration by email.

Step 5: Edit details pertaining to a large-scale importer or emissions pool

The details of all organisations (large-scale importer and emissions pools) should always be up to date. With the service 'Angaben zu GI oder EG bearbeiten' (Edit details pertaining to a large-scale importer or emissions pool), an organisation can modify its own details at any time. Navigate back to the service "CO2-Vollzug GI" (CO2 Regulations for large-scale importers). Under 'Angaben zu GI oder EG bearbeiten', select 'zum Service' (Go to service).



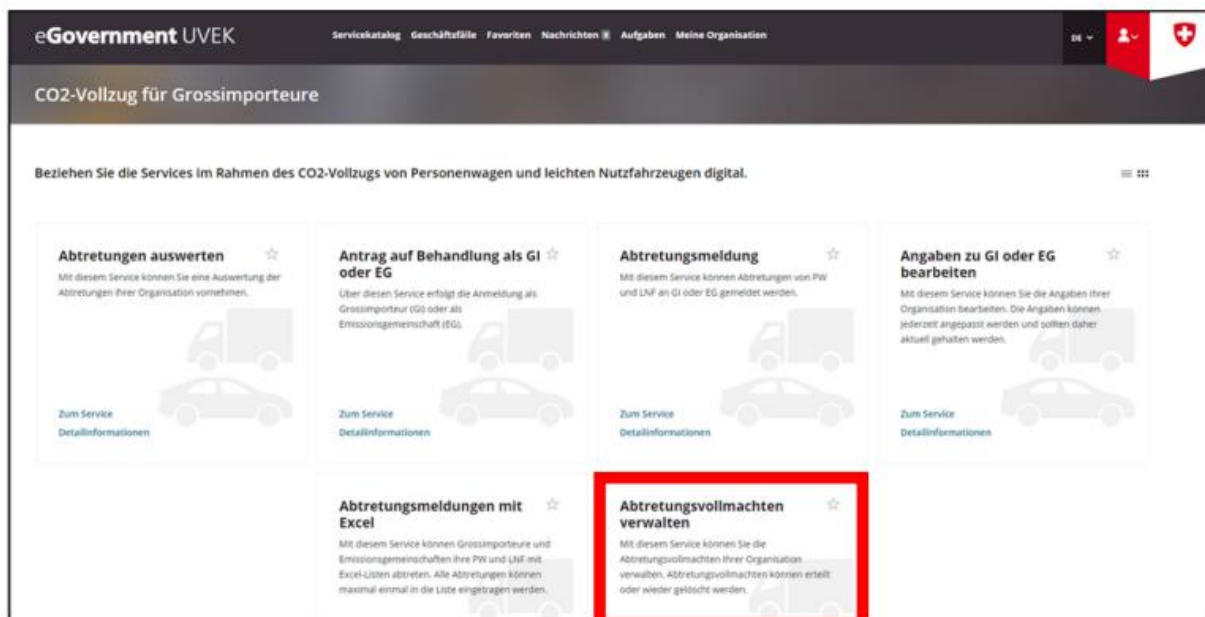

You will now be guided step-by-step through the service for editing details pertaining to a large-scale importer or emissions pool. Once the changes have been made, you will receive an email confirming that your details have been edited.

Step 6: Manage assignment powers

This service allows you to manage your organisation's assignment powers. Powers of assignment can be granted or revoked. Navigate to the 'Abtretungsvollmachten verwalten' (Manage assignment powers) service and select 'zum Service' (Go to service).



NB: When granting powers of assignment to other large-scale importers, please note the following:

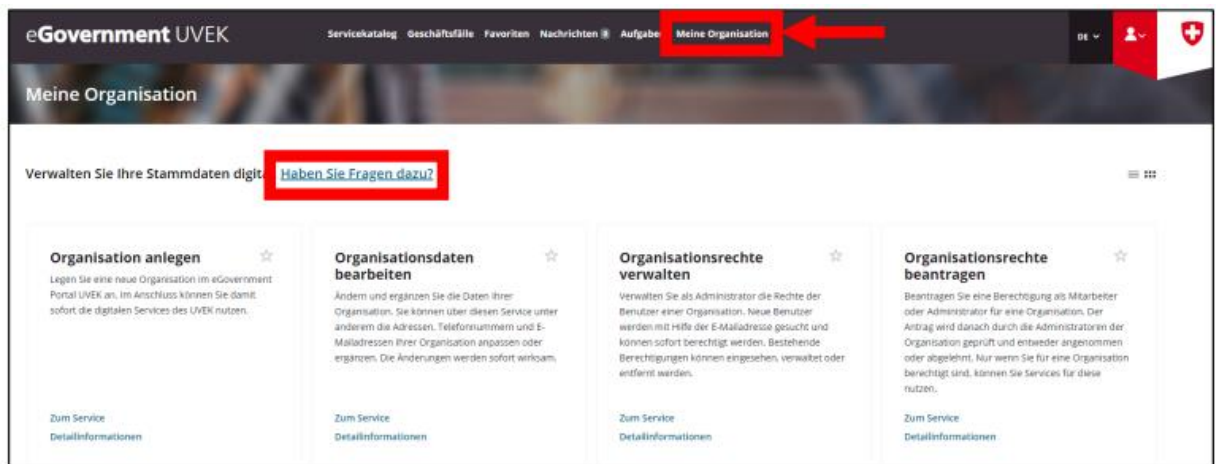


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- The large-scale importer code for the importer to be authorised is required. This means that this importer must also be already registered as a large-scale importer on the DETEC eGovernment portal.
